

We prioritise your child's safety with a secure, clean, and well-equipped facility. With a low child-to-caregiver ratio, we ensure each child receives personalised care and attention. Our curriculum fosters all aspects of your child's growth - social, cognitive, and physical.

Frequentiy Asked Questions · FAQs

1. What are the programme hours?

Our programme runs from 9:00am to 12 noon, Monday to Friday for a full academic year. We also offer day care after the program till 3:00 p.m.

2. What should I pack for my child?

Please pack a nutritious lunch, snacks, and milk for your child. *Include any necessary feeding utensils and clearly label all items with your child's name.

3. How do you ensure hygiene and safety during feeding?

We have a designated area for food storage and preparation. Our staff follows strict hygiene practices, and we have a fridge, microwave, and kettle to safely store and prepare your child's food.

4. What happens if my child has dietary restrictions or allergies?

Please inform us of any dietary restrictions or allergies. We will take all necessary precautions to ensure your child's safety. We have a trained nurse on campus who administers any medication and keeps a check of all allergies.

5. How do you handle naps and rest time?

We provide a quiet and comfortable space for naps and rest time. Each child has their own designated sleeping area with clean bedding.

6. What is your policy on illness?

To ensure the health and safety of all children, we ask that you keep your child at home if they are showing any signs of illness. Please refer to our health policy for more details.

7. How do you communicate with parents?

We provide regular updates on your child's progress and daily activities through our communication app and at scheduled parent-teacher meetings. We send a daily update on the day's happenings.

8. My child can identify numbers and letters. can he transition to Nursery?

In our toddler programme, we focus on nurturing social, emotional, and physical development areas, helping children develop social skills, independence, and the ability to follow routines. Transitioning too early without appropriate development of these skills might be unsettling for your child in the Nursery. We emphasise on the holistic development of the child's overall readiness before making the transition to ensure they thrive in their new environment.
